Protecting the lands and waters on which all life depends.

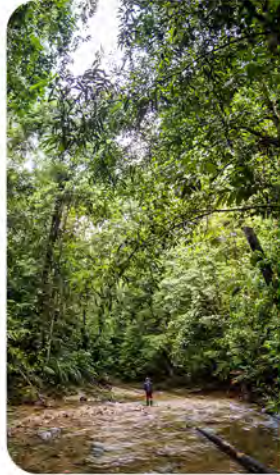

Our Program



Terrestrial

YKAN encourages sustainable forest management of 11 million hectares, protect 2 million hectares of forest from deforestation, and contributes to reduce carbon emissions by 26.6 million tons of carbon per year through four strategies:

1. Strengthening the mitigation framework at national & subnational levels
2. Supporting sustainable forest management
3. Supporting sustainable palm oil plantations
4. Strengthening community-based natural resource management



Oceans

YKAN encourage sustainable management of 10 million hectares of coastal and marine resources to support sustainable livelihoods and protection of Indonesia's biodiversity with a potential emission reduction of 200,000 tCO₂e/year through four strategies:

1. Developing a blue economy
2. Promoting sustainable fisheries
3. Building coastal resilience
4. Supporting ocean protection

600 villages in 9 provinces adopted SIGAP

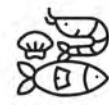
